- speak English at all times while at ECLC.
- attend school at ECLC full time and follow school policies, which include attendance and class work.
- study adult topics and subject matter in my class and participate in a mature manner and respect my classmates.
- remain in the homestay until I am legal age of 19 or have provided an alternate Canadian custodian.
- observe the house rules set by the host parent(s) such as curfews and other established rules.
- inform the Director of Student Services and/or Program Supervisor immediately if you feel uncomfortable with any staff person working in the program.
- obey national, provincial and local laws. For example, I will not use alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs.

While my child attends ECLC, I/we, ______ (parents) give non-expiring consent to

- my child's participation in school activities that involve parental waivers if signed by the Director of Student Services .
- having any photographs and/or video footage of him/her to used to promote the school via social media, school websites, or other promotional materials with no compensation.


ECLC's host parent will

- provide the host student with a welcoming and secure environment at all times.
- provide the host student with a private, comfortable room with a desk to study.
- provide three healthy and balanced meals a day.
- help the host student adapt to Canadian life.
- include the host student in all family activities.
- help the host student with bus routes.
- treat the host student with respect and tolerance.

East Coast Language College (ECLC) will

- counsel the student with problems affecting school and/or home life.
- mediate between the student and host family when/if necessary.
- help the student receive professional care while on ECLC premises.
- agree to move to another homestay within 24 hours if the student requests a change due to feeling uncomfortable about the intentions of any resident in the homestay.
- report serious problems to the student's parent(s) or agent if parent does not speak English.
- contact the student's parent(s) (or agent) in the case of an accident or serious illness.

We understand that we are expected to follow and obey all the terms stated with the consequence of the student being sent home at our own expense if we do not.
